

2017 Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK&HSKK)

HSK is China's only international standardized test of Chinese language proficiency for non-native Chinese speakers. It was launched by Hanban, part of the Chinese Ministry of Education, in an effort to better serve Chinese language learners, and assess non-native Chinese speakers' ability to use Chinese language in their daily, academic and professional lives. Test-takers with outstanding results can win a Confucius Institute Scholarship for short-term language study or research in China. HSK consists of six levels — level I, II, III, IV, V, and VI.

HSKK (HSK Speaking Test) assesses test takers' oral Chinese abilities. HSKK consists of three levels — Primary, Intermediate and Advanced.
